

Personalisation of social care services approved.

5 With reference to the minutes of the Health and Social Care Policy Development Committee of 22nd September 2010 (page 363 hereof) when it had been agreed to recommend to this committee approval of the implementation of personalised social care services in Glasgow, Councillor Kerr, Executive Member for Social Care, presented a report on the matter,

- (1) detailing proposals for the implementation of personalised social care services in Glasgow; and
- (2) advising of the key drivers for the implementation of personalisation in Glasgow.

After consideration, the committee

- (a) approved
 - (i) the implementation programme for personalisation of social care services to ensure a fairer, more equitable, transparent and effective allocation of available social care resources;
 - (ii) the proposed application of a Learning Disability Resource Allocation System;
 - (iii) revenue support of £520,000 per annum from the Council between 2011-13 to support the implementation;
 - (iv) the Council's position with respect to changes to the Independent Living Fund; and
 - (v) the application of a working assumption of a 20% resource re-direction in Glasgow, given the experience in England, which would be kept under review based on the particular experience here; and
- (b) noted the commitment of the Executive Director of Social Care Services to provide further detail on the assessment process and allocation of resources to a future meeting of the Health and Social Care Policy Development Committee.
